PROCESS & DUES

Once we receive your application, we will conduct a SLED Sex Offender Background Check as required by Rotary International and submit the application to the Membership Committee. The next step is board approval before a vote goes to the full membership. Once we send to the club for a vote, members have ten days to respond.

Once approved by the membership, we will alert you and provide you with an invoice. The invoice will contain the following:

Once the invoice is paid, your sponsor will set up your induction with our President, Glenn Matthews, and provide you with access to our club site, member database, and our weekly newsletter.

Going forward, if you should ever choose to resign from the Club, you must do so in writing and leave in good standing with all dues paid. We also encourage you to reach out to your sponsor and our club leadership throughout your membership.
